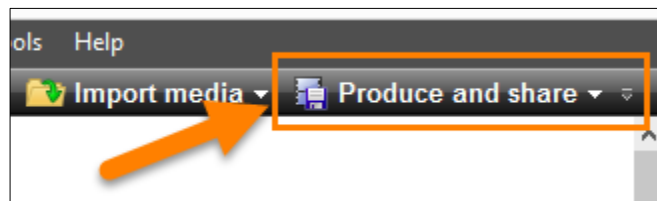


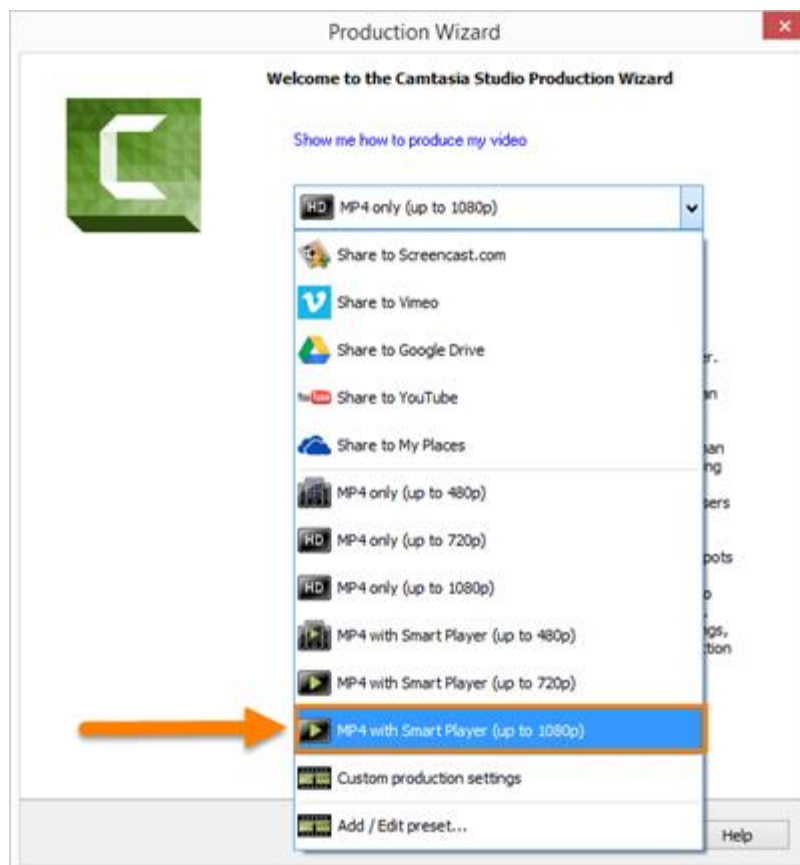
## Producing a Video with Quizzes – Graded

This tutorial will show you how to produce your video with quizzes that you plan on grading. These videos with quizzes are used for students to receive a grade that is populated into the grade book. This tutorial assumes you have already created a Camtasia video and added at least one quiz to it. Please review the tutorial on [Adding Quizzes to a Camtasia Video](#) to learn more.

1. Click Produce and Share.




2. In the drop-down list choose MP4 with Smart Player (up to 1080p).



3. Click the Next button.



4. Click the checkbox next to Report quiz results using.





5. Click the SCORM options button. Enter a Title for your video. make sure the following are selected: Version 1.2 and Produce both zip files and unzipped files. Click OK when done.



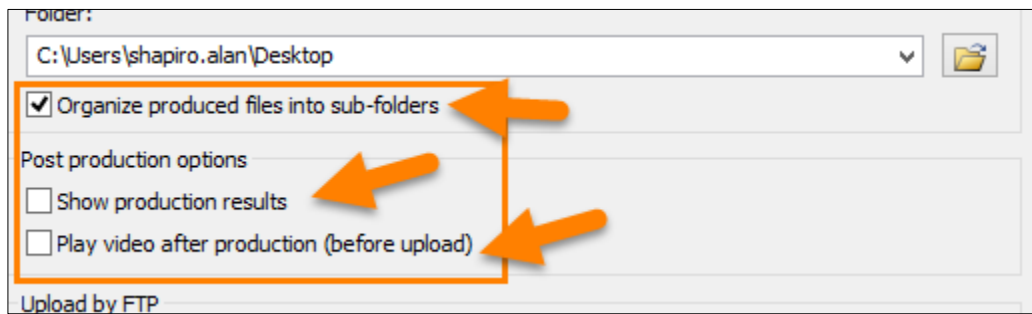

6. Make sure to give your production a name if it is not already filled in. If you want to change the location of where the files of the video output will be located click on the folder icon and choose a different location.

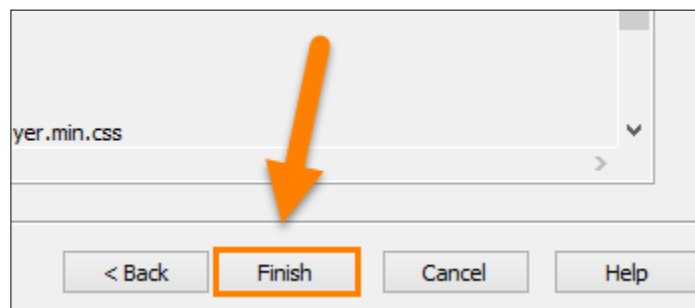

7. Make sure Organize produced files into sub-folders is checked. Make sure Show production results and Play video after production (before upload) are unchecked.



8. Click the Finish button to produce the video with quizzes – non-graded.



9. The Rendering Project window will appear. When this gets to 100%, your video will be produced.
